

# EXAM PROMOTION POLICY

## Classes : Nursery - V

School follows Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation as per CBSE guidelines. Promotion will be based on the performance in the unit-Tests. No retest will be conducted in principle. However exemption of one test per Subject per term will be granted in an academic session, whatsoever be the reason of absence. Attendance during Mid-Term and Annual Exam will be mandatory for all the Students.

### FOR CLASS XI

1. The total marks will be 200.

**Break up is as under :**

- 50% weight age of half Yearly. 20 marks of Monthly Test of 1st Terms.
- 20 marks of Monthly Test of 2nd Term. 10 marks of H.W./C.W.

**Attendance / Attitude :**

- 100% marks of final exam.

2. In Class XI, scoring 33% in theory and practical papers separately is mandatory.

3. Yearly Subject aggregate : Minimum 33% marks in each subject.

4. Supplementary : One subject only

Promotion to higher class is on the basis of whole years performance of the student, hence regularity in attendance is mandatory.
